Re: Review of obstetrical ultrasound studies

IMPORTANT

On October 09, 2003 you had an obstetrical ultrasound performed at Powell River General Hospital. As a result of our quality review process we have subsequently learned that the radiologist who read your ultrasound was not, in fact, authorized to do so. Although he is an experienced radiologist, it has come to our attention that he had not completed some of the additional education required to be reviewing ultrasound scans alone.

If you have not yet delivered, please discuss with your physician if you should consider a repeat ultrasound study. If you have already delivered, we want you to know that, despite this unfortunate situation, there is no clinical follow up indicated and no health-related action for you to take.

This is a regrettable situation and one that Vancouver Coastal Health acted swiftly to address the moment we became aware of it. As a result of this situation and our commitment to quality and safety, VCH has improved how we verify qualifications for care providers in order to prevent such a thing happening again.

Once again, we are bringing this to our attention as a sign of our commitment to patient care, safety and quality. There is no health impact on you or a need for you to take any further health-related action. We have shared this information with your physician, in confidence, who can discuss it further with you if you desire.
