 - 2. Feb 27 Queen of the Sun (bees) Nadja will lead up research and coordination of this event farmer's market honey ppl, bring honey to sell?
 - 3. March 26 Fresh Amy will lead up research and coordination of this event guest= Herman (wild flight farm?)
 - 4. April 30 Permaculture Jen will research movies and speakers, Mel will help to coordinate this event

ACTION: Mel to ask Shannon about her mom's bees, check venue dates and create poster outline by Jan 7th.
