After March 11 2011 when one of the biggest earthquakes in our life time triggered great Tsunami to take many lives and homes in Japan, I deeply appreciate your great support and friendship to my home country, Japan. Throughout 2 years, I do still remembers everyone support and donation to Japan.

Last fall, my friends who are ski and snowboard photographers in Tokyo got together and run a 3 day long charity event called **"What Can we Do"** to sell Tshirts and their snow mountain photographs to raise money. Overall of our charity event by selling our photographs and T-shirt as well as donations included from Revelstoke, BC Canada, we raised 3,277,621 yen (approximately \$40,000). We had to exclude some amounts for our running cost of this event, but the most of this donation was divided into and distributed to those three organizations above.

For this charity, twenty photographers donated their pictures to sell and promise to all that we will keep taking more attractive photographs with great gratitude to our supporters and thoughts of this 3.11 disaster.
