## Instructions to Property Owners

The *Community Charter* of the Province of British Columbia requires that in order for the petition process to be valid:

- 1. The person signing the form must be an owner of the property identified.
- 2. The form must include the full name, signature and residential address of the property owner.

The petition must be signed by the owners of at least 50% of the parcels that would be subject to the local service tax and the persons signing must be the owners of the parcels that in total represent at least 50% of the assessed value of land and improvements that would benefit from the local area service.
