Optional. If you wish to participate, please bring your own props. You can choose as many or as few as you like.

IMPORTANT: The Roxy Theatre has prohibited the use of rice, water pistols, hot dogs and prunes props. **PLEASE DO NOT USE THESE**

HOW TO USE PROPS:

- When using thrown props do not throw them at or toward the screen.
- Do not throw any props in the walkway ramps of the theatre! This can create a slipping hazard. We don't want anyone to get hurt! Contain props within the seating sections only.

PROPS LIST AND EXPLANATION:

RICE IS NOT ALLOWED! Rice is normally used this way: At the beginning of the film is the wedding of Ralph Hapschatt and Betty Munroe. As the newlyweds exit the church, you should throw the rice along with the on-screen wedding guests.

Newspapers: When Brad and Janet are caught in the storm, Janet covers her head with a newspaper "The Plain Dealer". At this point, you should likewise cover your head.

WATER PISTOLS ARE NOT ALLOWED! Water pistols are normally used this way: Members of the audience simulate the rainstorm that Brad and Janet are caught in. (Now you know why you use the newspapers)

Flashlights: During the "There's a light" verse of "Over at the Frankenstein Place" song you should light up the theatre with flashlights. **CANDLES, LIGHTERS AND OTHER OPEN FLAME ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE THEATRE!**

Rubber gloves: During and after the creation speech, Frank snaps his rubber gloves three times. Later, Magenta pulls these gloves off his hands. You should snap your gloves in sync each time to create a fantastic sound effect.

Noisemakers: At the end of the creation speech, the Transylvanians respond with applause and noisemakers. You should do the same. Noisemakers such as those used at parties or New Year's Eve.

Confetti: At the end of the "Charles Atlas Song" reprise, the Transylvanians throw confetti as Rocky and Frank head toward the bedroom. You should do the same.

Toilet paper: When Dr. Scott enters the lab, Brad cries out "Great Scott!" At this point, you should hurl rolls of toilet paper into the air.

Toast: When Frank proposes a toast at dinner, members of the audience throw toast into the air (**DRY TOAST, NOT BUTTERED**)

Party hat: At the dinner table, when Frank puts on a party hat, you should do the same.

Bell: During the song "Planet Schmanet Janet," ring the bell when Frank sings "Did you hear a bell ring?"

Playing Cards: During the song "I'm Going Home," Frank sings "Cards for sorrow, cards for pain". At this point you should shower the theatre with playing cards.

HOT DOGS AND PRUNES ARE NOT ALLOWED! Hot dogs and prunes are normally used this way: It has happened on occasion, that fans will throw hot dogs and prunes at their appropriate mention in the film. This should not be encouraged.
