

1 All Big Eddy property owners have very similar taxes as the property owners in Revelstoke but don't have the same benefits and infrastructure but city council still goes ahead with this moratorium on building permits which devalues property.

2 This decision will definitely decrease the values of Big Eddy property.

3 If the City insists on continuing with this moratorium on development in the Big Eddy taxes will have to be reduced accordingly to represent the values and there will be a great loss of tax revenue to the city.

4 There is a letter from the Interior Health dated December 20 ,2013 stating that there were concerns about the quality and security of the water supply in the Big Eddy .

5 When was council made aware of this and why is it just becoming known to the residents now?

This again causes grave concern for property owners in the Big Eddy as this will affect property values also.

6 The residents and business owners of the Big Eddy are forming a committee to represent them in these matters.

7 It is imperative that council and staff change their decision on this matter to avoid further damage to property owners in the Big Eddy.

8 If there is no clear and immediate action on these matters they will become major issues in the election in November.
